By 1990, over 4 million copies of AutoCAD had been sold worldwide. Today, Autodesk's CAD programs are installed on more than 200 million computers worldwide. History AutoCAD LT was initially released in December 1999. It was the first CAD program to allow users to draw and edit multiple documents at the same time. The editor makes it easy to organize, manage and edit files as well as large drawing projects. A number of other improvements and new features, which were later adopted by other programs, were also implemented. In May 2000, AutoCAD LT officially launched. It was still based on the same architecture as AutoCAD, but had a new user interface. The GUI is based on Windows 3.1 and uses a new drawing window, 3D views and is also much more mobile-like. AutoCAD released AutoCAD R14 in 2002, which would later be renamed to AutoCAD 2007 in May 2006.
